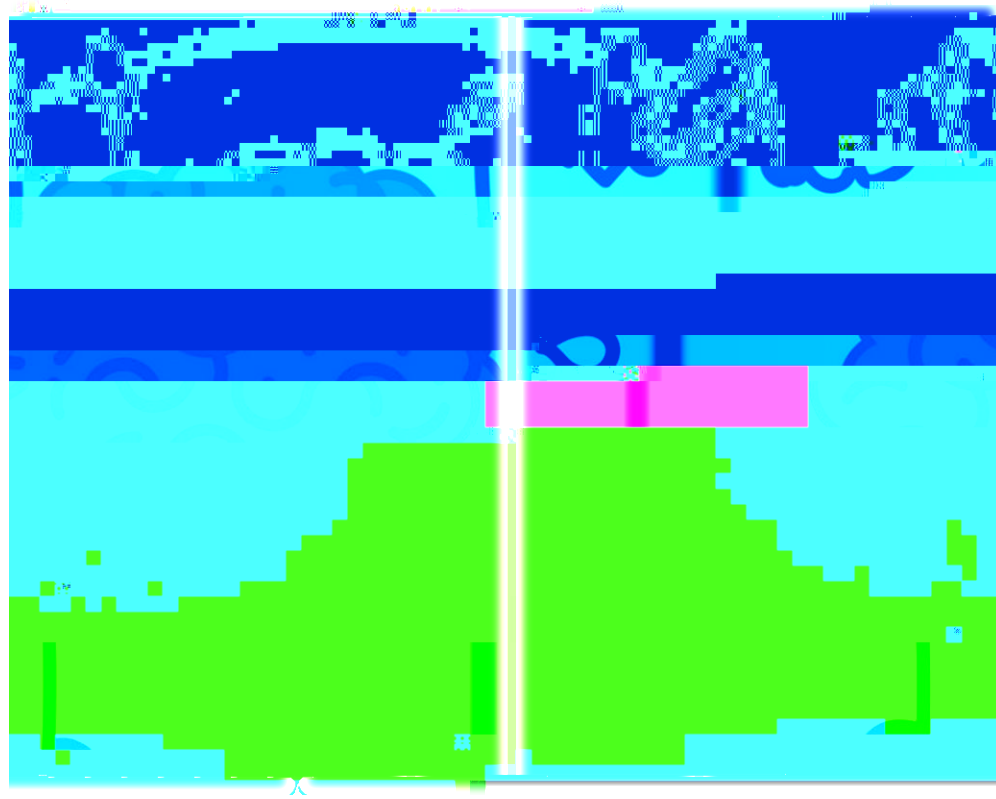

Try to get a good amount of sleep

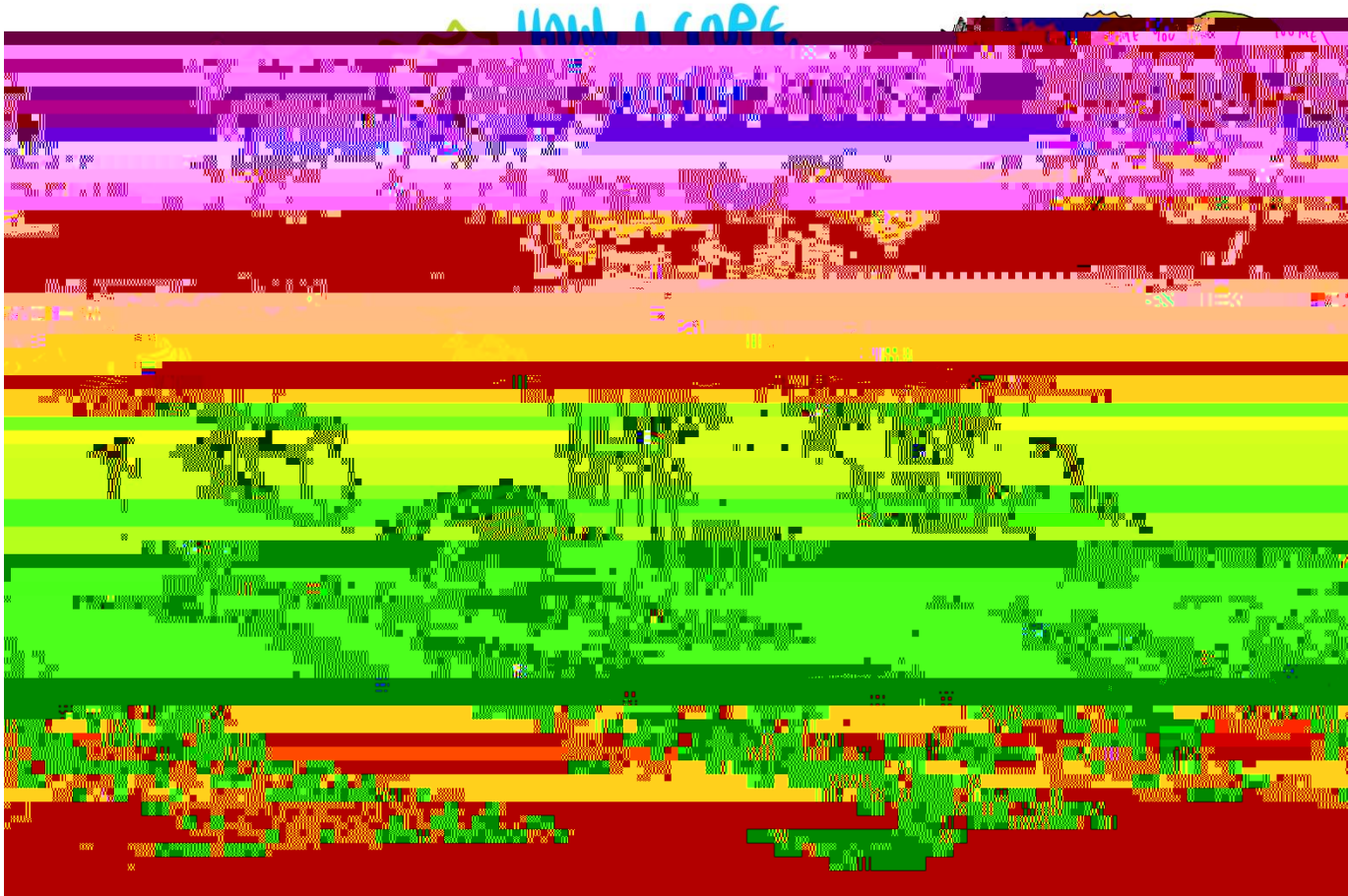
Eat regular healthy meals
